DEMOLITION WORKS AT 15 COLL PLACE

Glasgow Housing Association has appointed Safedem Ltd to demolish 15 Coll Place. This leaflet provides information about the demolition works and how surrounding residents may be affected.

DEMOLITION UPDATE

We have now started the next phase of the operational programme, which includes drilling works inside the blocks. These works can seem noisy at times, but all efforts are being made to keep the noise and dust to a minimum.

TEST BLAST - WEDNESDAY 30TH MARCH

We plan to carry out test blast operations on the morning of Wednesday 30th March. You may hear a few loud sirens and a few loud bangs when these tests are carried out. This is standard practice and will allow us to finalise our method of collapse, exclusion zone boundary, and date for demolition. Please note a small exclusion zone will be in place for these tests. Please be aware that these are routine operations and no one needs to be evacuated for these tests.

SITE SAFETY

It is vitally important that you stay well away from the demolition site. Our site fence clearly displays notices alerting passers-by to the dangers of demolition sites, and clearly advises to keep out. We would ask for co-operation from everyone within the community to warn children, visitors etc. to keep away from the site and to take extra care crossing the roads nearby.
